"My horse Holly is a 10 yr old Thoroughbred mare. After showing her in the hunters on a very busy show schedule for 2 years, my horse just did not "feel right" and she was starting to refuse to jump. A bone scan in 2005, revealed that she has arthritis in her back and both lower hock joints. We started with injections in her back and hocks. Initially, the injections seemed to work but then I decided to give her some time off from jumping and horse showing. When I decided I wanted to start competing again in 2008, I was introduced to Dr. Sheila Schils. After the first 2-day FES treatment on Holly's back, she felt like a new horse! Her back was so "open" and lateral work actually felt easy. The arch in her jump felt longer and rounder. And she was very straight to the jump and on the landing side. And, her confidence was back! We've also stated doing the FES treatment on her hind tendons and she seems to track up much better. Holly has been back in the show ring for a year now doing the jumpers and she absolutely loves her job. With the proper training program and the FES treatments as part of her maintenance, my horse feels amazing!"
